SUBJ: SLP Supervision of Clinical Fellows

Background:

The purpose of this memo is to outline an agreement between the Oak Grove Educators Association (“OGEA”) and Oak Grove School District (“District”) to provide a stipend to Speech and Language Pathologists (SLPs) who provide supervision to Clinical Fellows.

Proposal:

- SLPs who volunteer to supervise Clinical Fellows (CFs), with the approval of the Special Education Director.
- Clinical Fellows are those who are transitioning from being a student and being an independent provider of clinical services. It is a mentored professional experience after they complete their academic coursework and clinical practicum.

For each Clinical Fellow (CF), unit members may apply for and be selected for assignments as mentors. The District will pay an annual stipend of \$1,500 to each unit member assigned to mentor one CF and \$1,900 for each unit member assigned to mentor two or more employees. This stipend will be paid in the same manner as the District Induction Mentor Stipend, and will be prorated for mentors employed less than full-time.

This agreement will be in effect for the 2024/25 School Year and will be re-evaluated next school year.
